Brief Overview of TCC 2018-19 Activities:

- Composed a resolution regarding appointments and reappointments of Deans. Presented to SACUA Feb. 2019
- Bylaw language revisions: adjusted inconsistent language in the Regents Bylaws and UM Faculty Handbook (inconsistent in that the practice does not match the policy description)
- Resolution on Governance, affirming faculty governance on all three campuses at all levels; i.e. unilateral decisions should not be made and meaningful faculty input is fundamental. Approved by Senate Assembly Feb. 2019
- Minor changes to Senate Assembly language: Dearborn and Flint are campuses not units
- Tri-Campus Faculty Fellowship in Academic Excellence proposal; initial proposal reviewed and approved by SACUA in principle in Winter 2019.
 - Provost has expressed interest in principle

Fellowship will now be presented to Senate Assembly in October 2019 for comments and then back to SACUA for comments. During 2019-20 the TCC will continue to work on the parameters of the fellowship and how it would be implemented.
