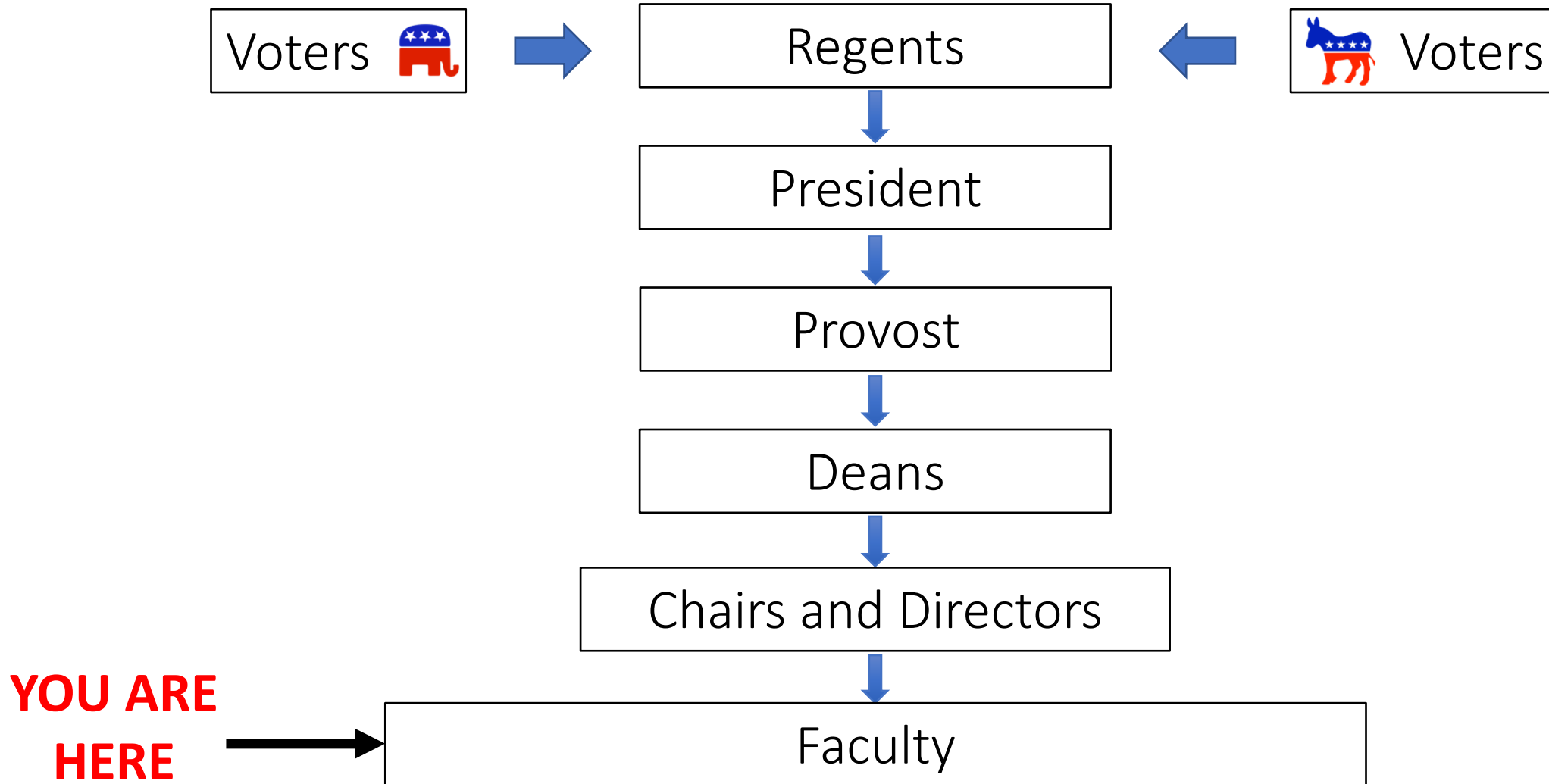




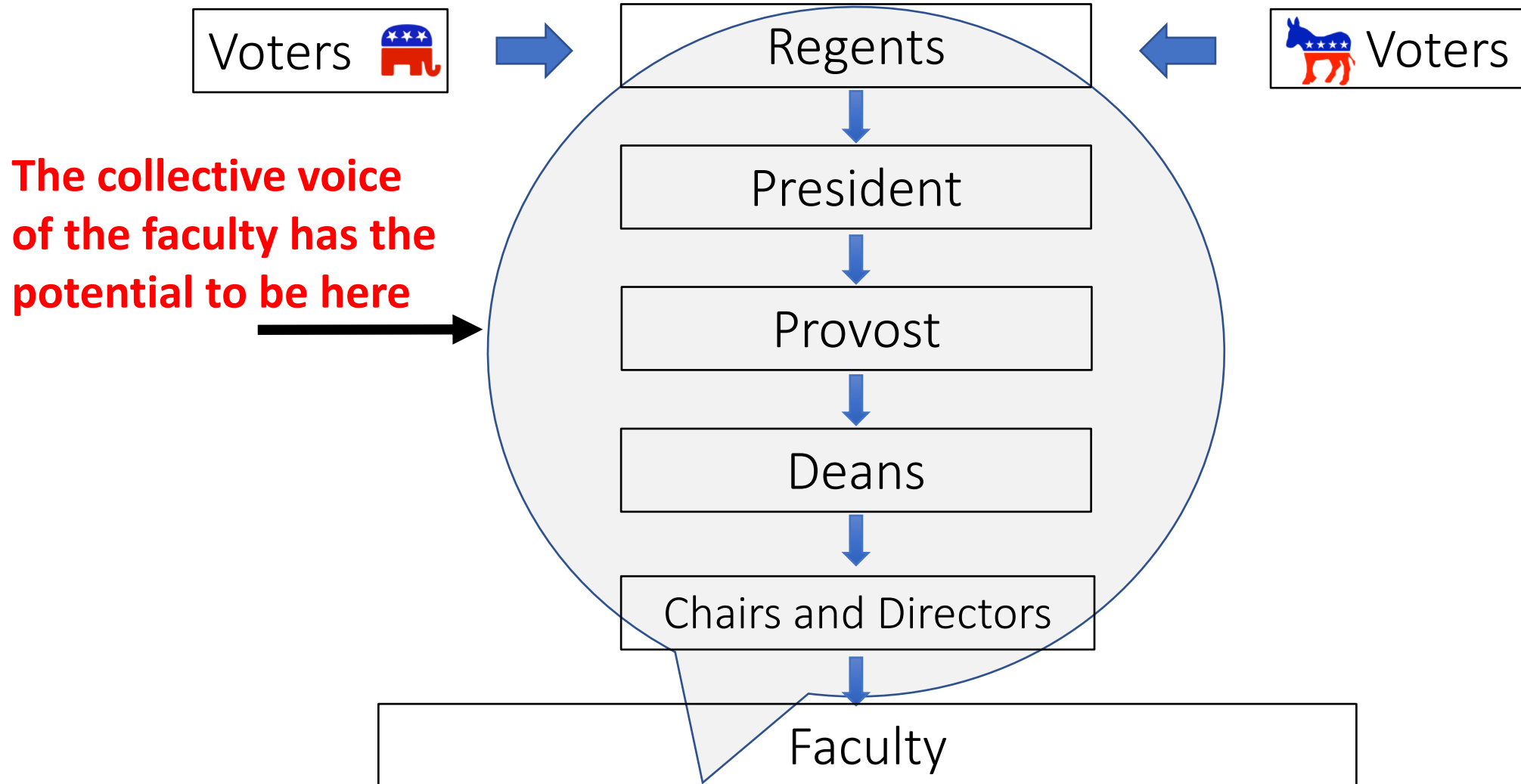

9 elected Senate Assembly members, plus Secretary who does not have voting rights

# Functions of Senate Assembly and SACUA

## The Senate Assembly:

- Meets monthly
- Chooses members to serve on SACUA
- Establishes committees

## Senate Advisory Committee on University Affairs (SACUA):

- Meets weekly (on weeks when Senate Assembly is not meeting)
- Advises and consults with the president of the university on matters of university policy
- Serves as an instrument to effect actions of the Senate and the Assembly
- Nominates and supervises committees of the Assembly



## Senate Assembly Advisory Committees

- Senate Assembly standing committees advise and consult with vice presidents of the university, and SACUA consults with and advises the president.
- Other Senate Assembly committees are advisory more broadly, and are not specific to any one VP.
- Committees provide an important mechanism to bring faculty concerns to the University's Executive Officers and beyond.
