- UMich transition to Duo access
 - All unregistered users will be auto-enrolled by deadline
 - UMHS Faculty/staff by October 2018
 - LS&A/Central Campus by January 2019
 - Students by Fall'19 (earlier if they are employed!)
 - All 3 UM campuses (AA, Flint and Dearborn) are implementing Duo
 - ...
- SULs (Security Unit Liaisons) – mediate free token distributions within academic units
- For stolen/lost devices – call **4-Help** immediately for stopping services
- Duo Options: Digital tokenizer, YubiKey, Smart phones, land-line phones (see slidedeck)
- Duo authentication period (hours – to – days), may later be customizable. Pros/cons of extended periods
- No accounts with Duo access have been compromised in past year.
- Duo is not a silver bullet, but significant improvement in security

- UM was one of the first institutions in the US to utilize 2-factor authentication (since 2005)
