- Andrew Rosenberg oversees the massive campus IT organization including the HITS (MSIS + MCIT, Clinical Enterprise IT) and Research IT
- Current free-services (e.g., Yottabyte) may eventually become paid for (for faculty/research teams)
- Price incentives to leverage department/school contributions, costs and use
- “Silver Plan” – 3-tier system
  - 80%-ers: minimal needs (80% of the users), consume minimal resources for free
    - All students are part of 80%-ers, unless they are part of 20%-er lab projects
  - 19%-ers: faculty/research groups consuming the majority of the resources, e.g., 100-1,000’s of cores, charged only for direct use, funds used for HW-replacements
  - 1%-ers: Big Team Collab projects, require custom engineering, costs are charged for labor, as needed
  - Plan proposed in 2017, but on hold due to CIO changes. Plan requires agreement between the Big-3, LS&A, CoE, SoM.
- Data Den Archive – faculty pay once, UM pays for ongoing support. \$33/TB/Yr, includes encryption
