Topic of Discussion: COVID-19 Vaccination Program Roll-out at Michigan Medicine

Vaccinations:

- Ford Auditorium: goal is to administer 500 vaccines a day.
- January off-site locations: 5-10 vaccinators per site
- Per day goal: 1,500 – 2,000 vaccines administered
- Michigan Medicine will request 10,000 doses per week. We will typically not receive less than 975 doses, but we never know what we will receive.

Outside of Michigan Medicine:

- CVS has been subcontracted to administer the vaccine to people residing in nursing homes and employees.
- Washtenaw County will vaccinate 45,000 people. The challenge will be to find vaccinators.

Dr. Runge comments:

- Dashboard will be formulated to provide data on vaccination stats.
- It is still unknown if COVID-19 vaccines will be required.
- Michigan Medicine is developing marketing/videos & outreach efforts to ensure that the distribution of the vaccine is equitable. We will be reaching out to faith organizations; seeking black doctors, nurses, residents and sports figures to film videos and/or still pictures receiving the vaccine.
- COVID-19 Saliva testing is being held in Towsley.
