

## Update on faculty senate motions follow-up

### Motion 1: Work Connections

- SACUA voted to approve a working group to look further into Work Connections. Charges include:
  - Review and identify items in Motion 1 that are requested to be implemented.
  - Review existing policies, procedures, and practices followed by Work Connections, and identify gaps, particularly concerning consideration of faculty requests for approval of work restrictions.
  - Identify and recommend circumstances under which a determination made by Work Connections may be reconsidered.
  - Recommend educational and outreach activities that will clarify the role of Work Connections and its processes.
  - Prepare a report with recommendations for implementation to present to SACUA for continued follow up.

### Motion 2: Adequacy of COVID policies

- Per CDC guidance for Institutions of Higher Education, if a fully vaccinated person came into [close contact](#) with someone with COVID-19, they should get tested within 5-7 days. The University does not currently conduct reliable contact tracing in the classroom since it does not monitor classroom seating arrangements.
- University is considering requiring booster shots, especially once CDC declares that being 'fully vaccinated' includes getting a booster.

### Motion 4: Handling of sexual misconduct

- SACUA voted to approve a working group on addressing sexual and gender-based misconduct. Charges include:
  - Review and identify items in Motion 4 that are requested to be implemented.
  - Review and consider existing written policies, procedures, and practices, including SPGs to determine where items requested in Motion 4 could logically reside.
  - Identify gaps where new policies, procedures, and practices, including SPGs could be implemented.
  - Prepare a report with recommendations for implementation to present to SACUA.
