 - i. Work with Ravi's staff to get information:
 - 1. A list of all the colleges/units on the Ann Arbor, Dearborn, and Flint campuses
 - 2. A list of the different levels of support that exist in ITS, and an explanation for how this support is currently distributed across the colleges/units on the 3 campuses
 - ii. Conduct a survey of faculty that will include an overview of the levels of IT support that supports their work/research and gather information about whether or not they feel that level of support is being met.
 - One goal is to understand where the disconnects are, and to identify and address the inequities and access issues. Another goal is to identify how best to make existing services and tools more visible and accessible across the colleges/units/campuses.
 - 2. Some challenges with this approach include scope of what's



included in "IT support" and being succinct in explaining current levels of service to provide survey participants with enough information to accurately fill out the survey. Also including all the units across all three campuses will generate a TON of data, and processing, understanding, and taking action on that gathered data will take a lot of time and expertise beyond this current Faculty Senate IT Committee.
