Number of respondents: 1662

Questions asked in the survey:

(Q1) Overall, the University's current COVID policies specific to teaching strike an even balance between reasonable protection from COVID exposure in the classroom and effective teaching.

(Q2) Overall, the University's current COVID policies specific to work accommodations for personal and family health issues strike an even balance between the safety of university faculty and the needs of the University.

(Q3) Overall, the University's current policy that promotes extreme flexibility regarding student absences due to illness, COVID, or quarantine still allows me to teach effectively.

(Q4) I can temporarily move my course to remote teaching without any fear of explicit or implicit retribution from administrators.

(Q5) The University has provided satisfactory support to faculty with children when COVID-based school closures or isolation orders require children to stay home.

(Q6) The University's COVID policies are clearly and consistently communicated to faculty.

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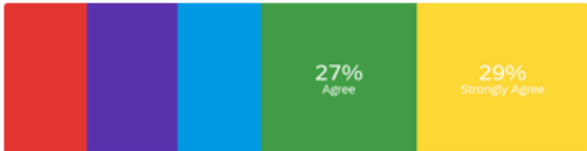

Figure 1. Combined responses of all faculty who responded to the survey.

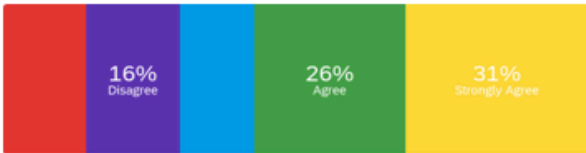

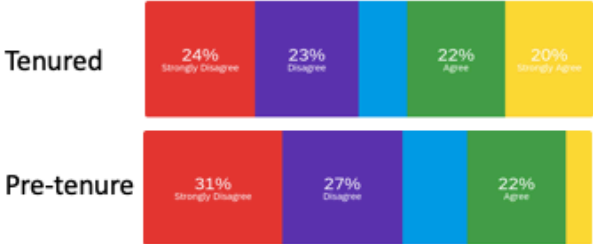

Figure 3. Responses from tenured vs. non-tenured faculty (T/T).

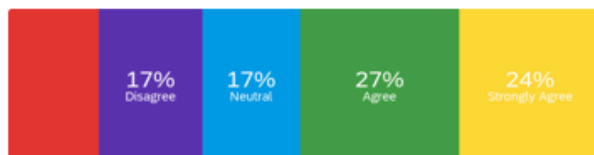

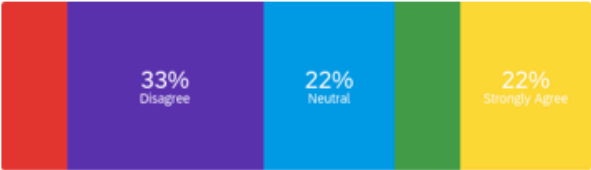

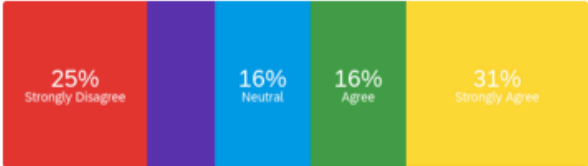

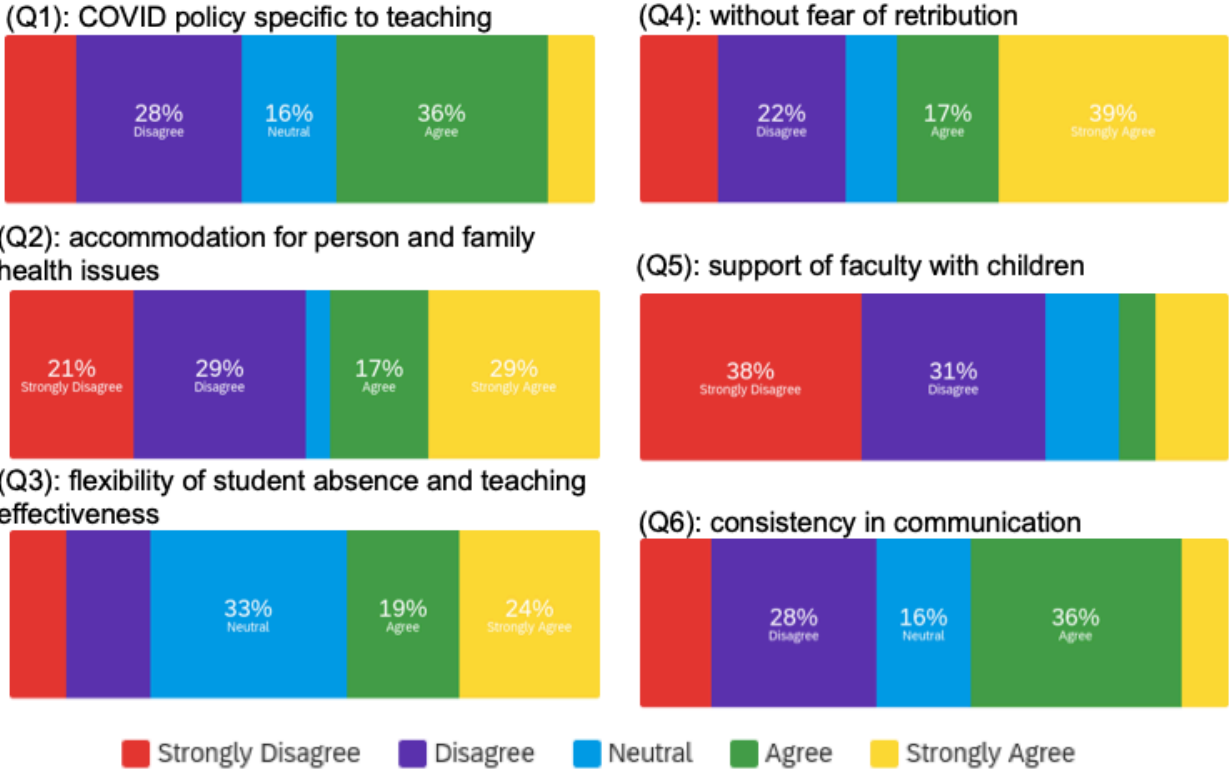

Figure 10. Responses from faculty in Education.

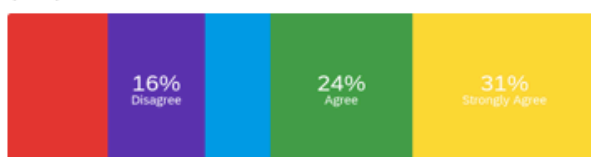

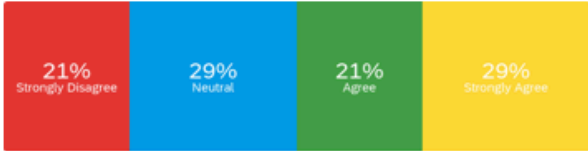

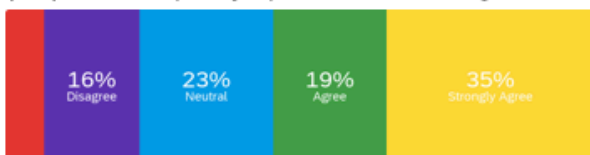

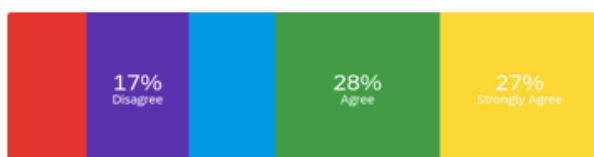

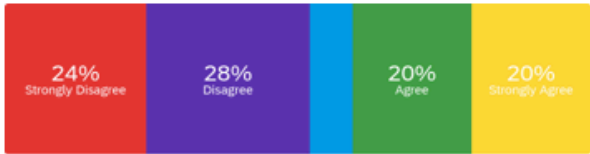

Figure 17. Responses from faculty in Medicine.

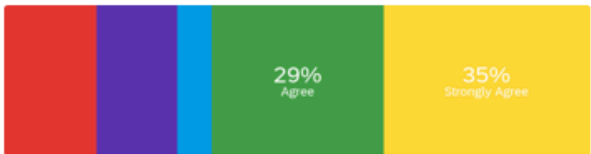

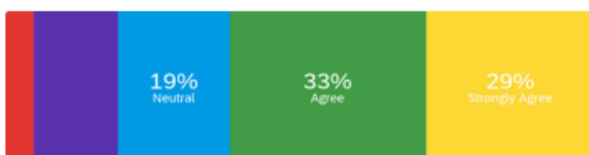

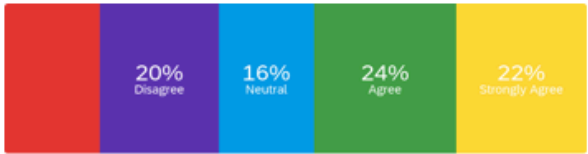

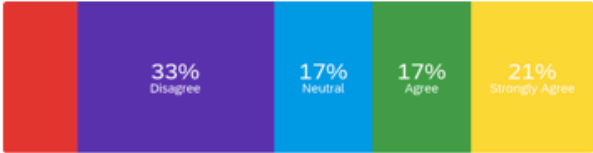

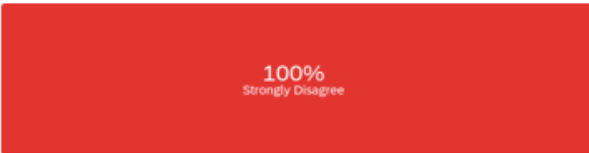

Figure 24: Responses from faculty in Institute of Social Research.

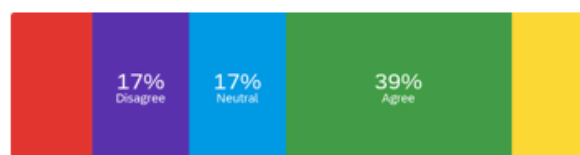
