

Possible Recommendations

- Recommendation 1: Expand membership to include (those >50% appointment):
- Clinical faculty members at all ranks shall be incorporated into full voting membership of the University of Michigan Faculty Senate, with all the associated rights, privileges, and responsibilities
- Lecturers shall be incorporated into full voting membership of the University of Michigan Faculty Senate, with all the associated rights, privileges, and responsibilities

Restructuring for Senate Assembly

- Recommendation 2: The number of seats in the Senate Assembly shall be increased such that no schools/colleges will lose a seat.
 Medical school is capped at 17 seats when clinical faculty is added
- Recommendation 3: All faculty senate members shall be eligible for election to the Senate Assembly
- Recommendation 4: Faculty votes will be tallied by track
 (Librarians/Archivists/Curators, Research track, Tenure track, Clinical track, Lecturer) and summed
