Faculty Senate Office Activities

The FSO continues to be productive. Examples of the activities the FSO has been engaged in include the following:

- Ann and I continue working through an enormous amount of committee scheduling and event planning tasks.
- Added undergraduate and graduate student representatives nominated by Central Student Government to most of the committees, including the webpages and MCommunity groups.
 - Sent emails to each chair with the students CC'd in order to connect chairs and students with each other.
- Met with IT regarding the Regent Candidate Forum to prepare for the event, including being able to include pre-recorded questions from faculty members not present physically.
- Sent follow-up emails and made phone calls to the Regent candidates from the major parties that we had not heard a response from.
 - We currently have not received a response to our invite from Democratic candidate
 Regent Behm and Republican candidate Lena Epstein.
 - Current attendees are Democratic candidate Regent White, Republican candidate Sevag
 Vartanian, and Green Party candidate Sherry Wells.
- Arranged for upcoming SACUA guests from the ECRT and the CCRT.
- Updated the charge documents for most of the committees, with a few that are still being revised.
- Prepared the September newsletter for sending to the Faculty.
- Sent bios for SACUA's leadership to President-Elect Ono's staff in preparation for an upcoming meeting with him.
- Solicited RSVPs and coordinated with caterers for two luncheons: committee chair luncheon and the committee member luncheon.

- Worked on SACUA Retreat planning with our facilitator.
- Drafted a proposal regarding a new Ethics and Compliance Office.
