

Development receives priorities from the Presidents, as well as from the units and runs with them.

Development includes capital and facilities, but that is a smaller area. Research, scholarships, programmatic, etc. are areas that donors tend to prefer to focus on at this point. Donors are more interested in projects they are passionate about.

The Office of Development only accept gifts that further the mission of the University of Michigan. Donors want to see progress on big goals, as UM is to be a leader of innovation.
