- 2- **Discussion item #1**: Review of SPG Deficiencies and Recommendations We will analyze and finalize our conclusions on the deficiencies and recommendations identified in the University of Michigan's current Standard Practice Guide (SPG).

<u>Objectives</u>: Scrutinize the existing UM Standard Practice Guide in the context of protecting faculty against retaliation to: (a) Formulate policy recommendations that aim to safeguard faculty independence within classrooms, including curriculum, pedagogical techniques, and evaluation processes, countering potential student backlash that might seek administrative sanctions. And (b) Protect faculty from retaliatory actions initiated by fellow faculty members or administrators.

<u>Results</u>: Our analysis has identified multiple areas requiring improvement within the SPG as it relates to faculty protection against retaliation. As the Committee on Economic and Social Well-Being of Faculty (CESWF), we are focused on addressing these gaps to reinforce the university's policies, ensuring stronger protection and more equitable investigation processes. The key points from our analysis are detailed in the attached document.
