3:00-3:05pm: Call to Order, Approval of Agenda and Minutes, Announcements

The agenda was approved. The minutes for the April FAAC meeting were approved. Introductions are made.

3:05-3:35pm: Updates on Carbon Neutrality (Guest: AVP Shana Weber)

<u>Summary</u>: AVP Weber provided an update on the progress made and current plans by the University of Michigan to reach its carbon neutrality goals. AVP Weber provided background information on her career, and what drew her to her current role at UM. One of the four primary impact areas of UM's Vision 2034 plan is "Climate action, sustainability, and environmental justice." The size and goals of UM provide challenges and opportunities. UM has set large goals to serve as a model for other institutions to follow.


UM has committed to having a carbon neutral footprint for emissions from sources the university owns and operates directly, as well as emissions from purchased electricity. Under consideration are indirect emissions from U-M activities, but from sources not owned or controlled by the university. Members of the committee note that this third scope is incredibly important. The slideshow shown in the meeting will be provided to the committee for further review.

Members of the committee ask questions related to getting UM to carbon neutral. A point is raised about the energy cost of Artificial Intelligence. The investment policy is discussed.
