WHEREAS our graduate students are our collaborators, interlocutors, and junior colleagues,

WHEREAS the university has not made a second offer to GEO to end the strike,

WHEREAS GEO signaled that they were willing to negotiate in good faith and accept compromise on their demands,

WHEREAS we believe the campus needs to proceed in a collaborative spirit to address our shared concerns rather than pit community members against each other,

RESOLVED that the faculty object to the University's decision to file for an injunction and restraining order against GEO,

RESOLVED that the faculty demand that the University withdraw its request for an injunction and restraining order,

RESOLVED that the faculty demand that the University make a good faith offer to GEO to end the strike.
